We invite you to this from October 6th to 8th, 2021 in cooperation with the German Center for Venetian Studies. The symposium deals with the question of the extent to which an individual city identity related to the genius loci can shape the way into the future.

The start is on 6 October in the afternoon with a welcome at the Baukulturmobil and a visit to the M9 museum in Mestre and an exchange of experiences between European Baukultur institutions for invited guests. The international symposium will take place in Venice on the second day, October 7th.

On October 8th, the foundation will be offering guided tours of the Architecture Biennale (for a fee).
